New, easier way to request public records

Surprise launches new public records request system

Mon, Mar 20, 2023

The City of Surprise is moving to a new public records request system beginning March 20, providing a simpler and more centralized way of making online requests for public records and information, such as electronic documents, videos and audio files.

This new website-based software technology by GovQA can be accessed through <u>surpriseaz.gov/RecordsRequest</u>. All public records should be requested through GovQA, including records from the Police Department, Fire-Medical Department, City Court and City Clerk's Office.

In addition to offering one centralized place for all City records requests, GovQA allows users to track their requests online through a secure portal. The new online intake form will also help refine requests, reducing the need for clarification and paperwork.

WHAT IS A PRESS RELEASE?

A press release is an official statement delivered to members of the news media for the purpose of providing information, creating an official statement, or making an announcement directed for public release.

NATIONAL COMMUNITY SURVEY

- Scientific survey conducted every two years; next one will be in 2025
- Serves as city services report card
 - Provides residents the opportunity to tell us what city services shine / areas in which to improve
- Confidential
 - Third-party runs the survey; city does not know who participates, only receives aggregate results
- Benchmark report compares our services with cities across the country
