
Club Update

- Renew/Join ONLINE






- CAM Cards



To pre-register: Go to the GCC website


- Log into the GCC website


Brief Overview of Fiber Optic

- A fiber connection that uses light signals to send data to and from your computer or television.
- Fiber internet uses fiber-optic cables instead of copper wires.
- The fiber-optic cables are filled with glass filaments. Information is sent back and forth by lasers and light signals




Why Does this Matter?

- Fiber connections don't get distorted over long distances like copper wire connections do.
- DSL & cable internet rely on Copper wires-same kind used to transmit your voice over a telephone line.
- Length of internet cable also matters can distort the signal
- Transmission speed depends on how much data the infrastructure can handle.




Who is Zona Wyyred?

- Acquired Zona Communications in 2019






