  - U.S. Federal Census images and indexes from 1790 to 1930;
  - Map Center containing more than 1,000 historical maps;
  - American Genealogical Biographical Index (over 200 volumes)
  - Great Migration Begins: Immigrants to New England, 1620-1630
  - Social Security Death Index (updated monthly)
  - WWI Draft Registration Cards
  - Federal Slave Narratives; and a strong Civil War collection. Ancestry Library Edition updates continually
