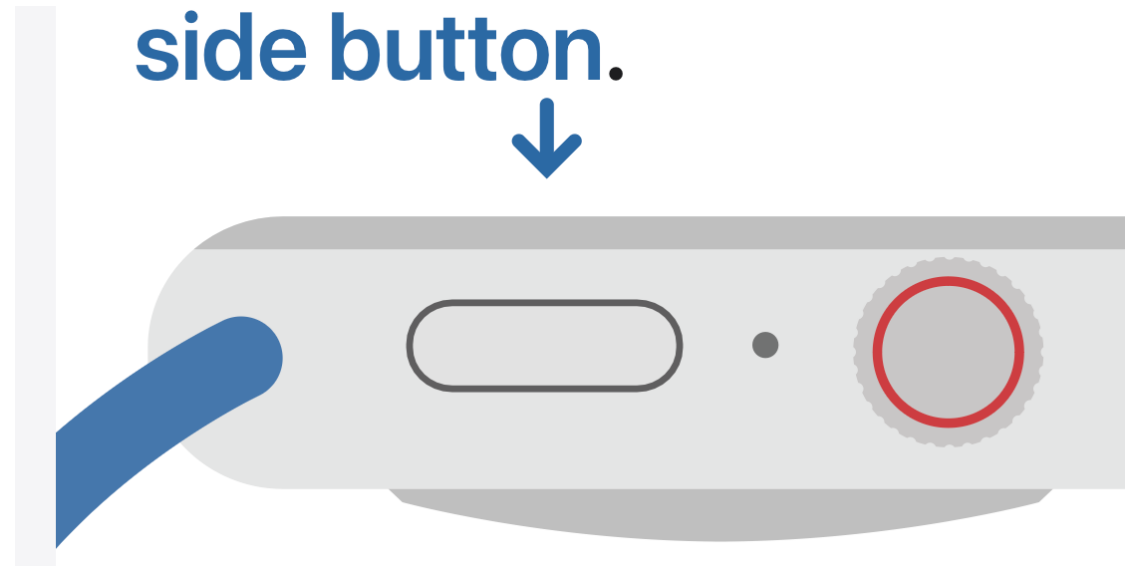

STANDBY MODE

When you charge your iPhone and turn it to landscape mode, iOS 17 will change the display to a new StandBy mode. It shows a big clock you can read from a long way away, and swiping up cycles through clock styles. Swipe left and right to pass through highlight photos.

But the real magic comes from widgets support, including Smart Stacks and Live Activities. You can see home controls, calendar, weather, and even see when your food delivery is going to arrive. Because they're Smart Stacks, they learn which widget you want to see by location and time of day and attempt to show you the one that matters most, but you can always swipe between them.

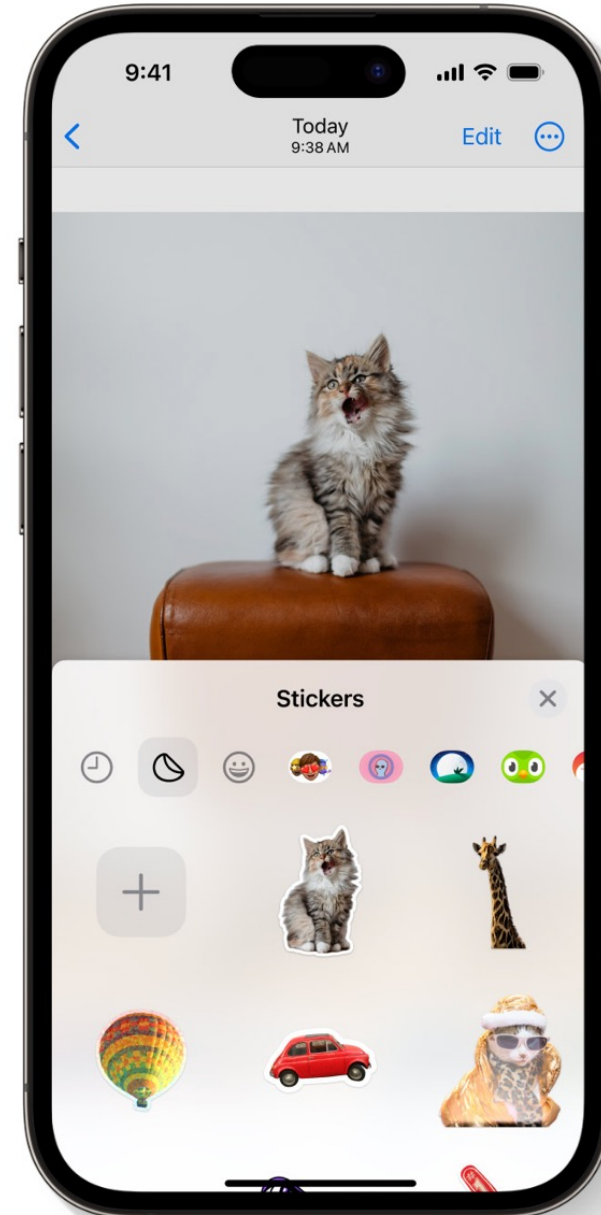
The feature doesn't require a MagSafe charging stand, but if you use one, your iPhone will learn what you want to see for each different stand you use.

Name Drop

NameDrop is a new AirDrop feature that is designed to share contact information only with intended recipients. It debuted in September under iOS 17.

Despite warnings from many police departments nationwide, NameDrop does not automatically share your contact information with other iPhone users near you.

Name Drop – How Does It Work?

In order [to use NameDrop](#), both users must unlock their device, hold it within a few centimeters of another person's iPhone or Apple Watch to establish a connection, then select and confirm what, if any, contact information to share.

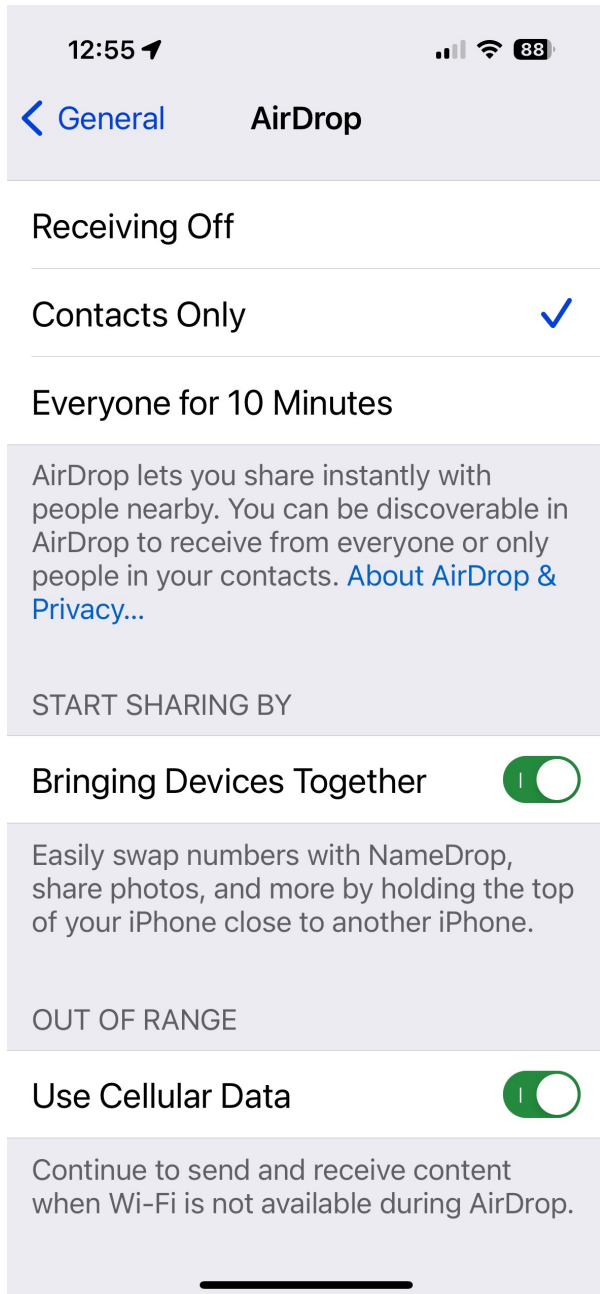
After a short time, both devices will vibrate and glow at the top of their displays, indicating a connection is being made. Both users must then continue to hold their devices near each other until the NameDrop option appears on both screens.

Name Drop – How Does It Work?



While the NameDrop feature does make it easier to exchange contact information between two devices, Apple says no contact information is automatically shared when two devices are brought together without a user taking action, such as selecting what information they want to send and then tapping on share to exchange it.

“NameDrop isn’t necessarily something to be concerned about, it simplifies sharing contact details but still provides you with the final say in if information is shared

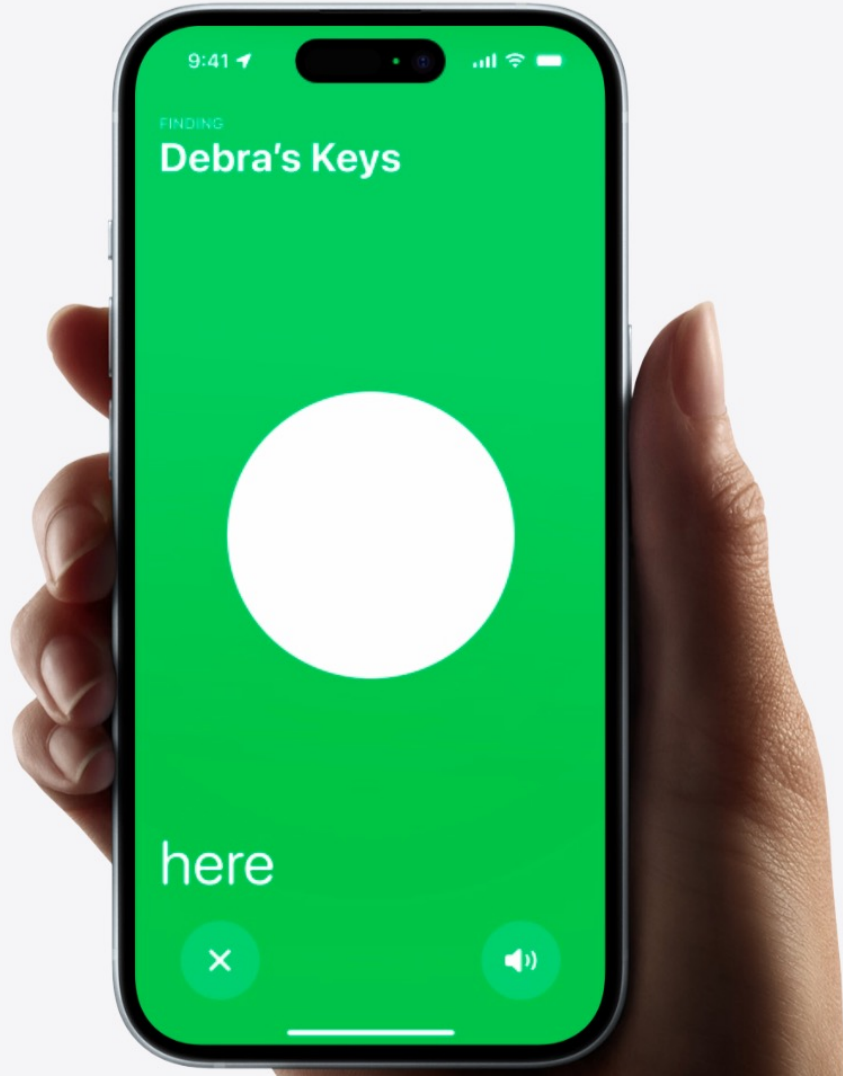
- 1.Go to Settings
- 2.Tap General
- 3.Tap AirDrop
- 4.Go to Start Sharing By
- 5.Toggle Bring Devices Together off

How does it work?

Your AirTag sends out a secure Bluetooth signal that can be detected by nearby devices in the Find My network. These devices send the location of your AirTag to iCloud — then you can go to the Find My app and see it on a map. The whole process is anonymous and encrypted to protect your privacy. And it's efficient, so there's no need to worry about battery life or data usage.



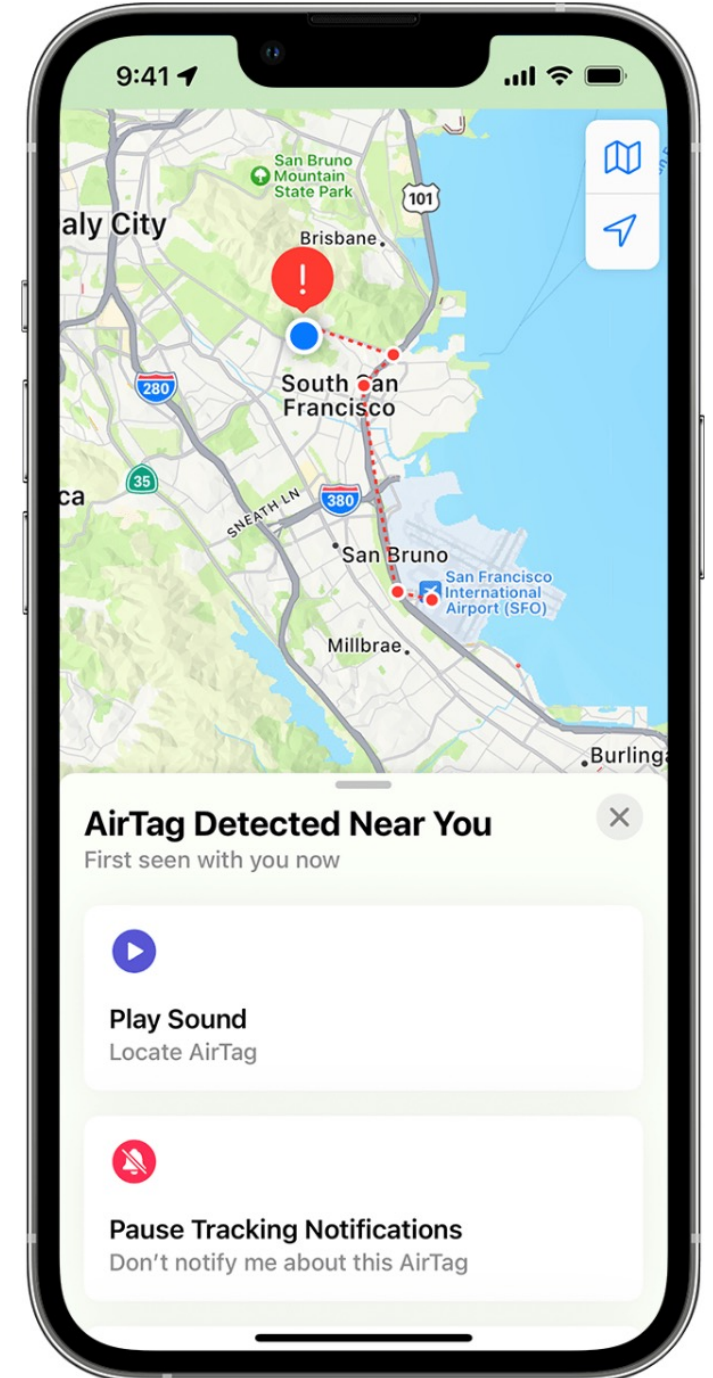
Unwanted Tracking

If you see an alert on your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch, an item compatible with the Find My network could be traveling with you, and the owner might be able to see its location.



What To Do

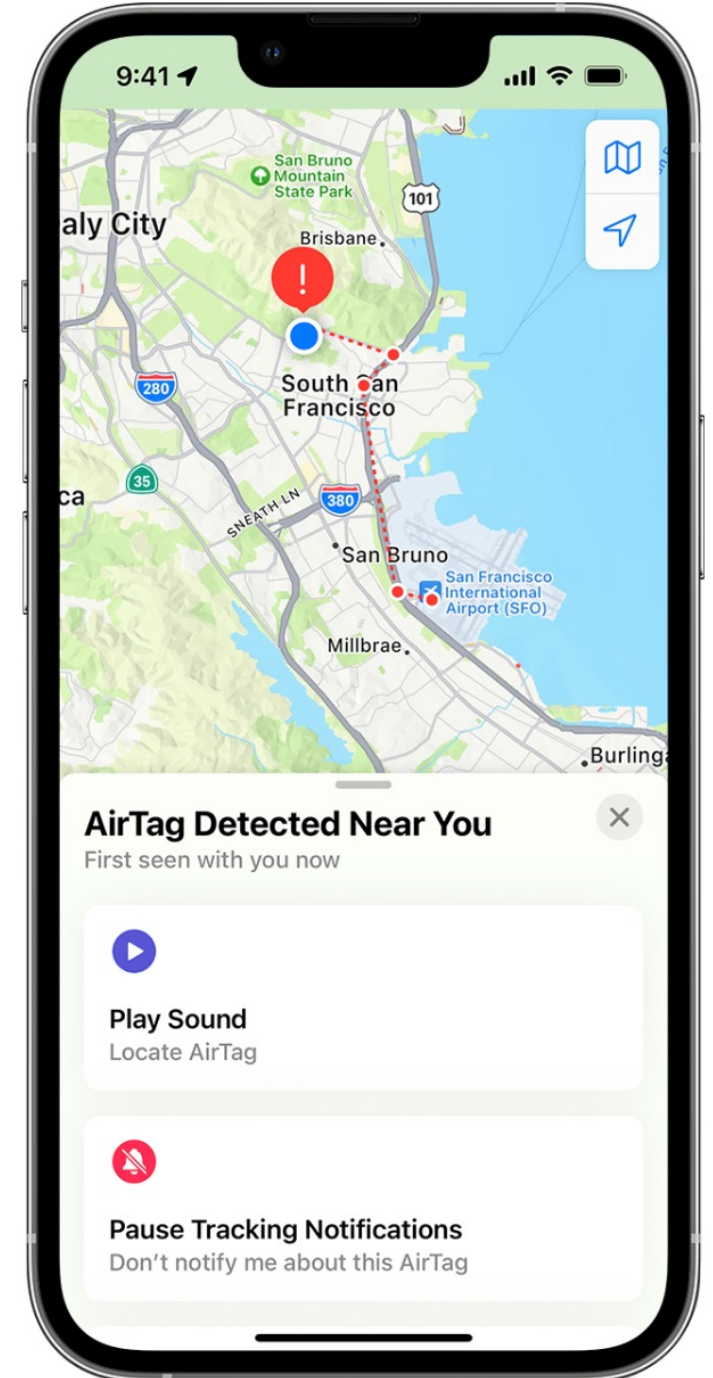
Find My displays a map of where the AirTag, Find My network accessory, or set of AirPods has been observed with you. The red dots show where the unknown item was detected near your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch. The dashed lines connecting the red dots help indicate the sequence where the item was detected with you.



What To Do

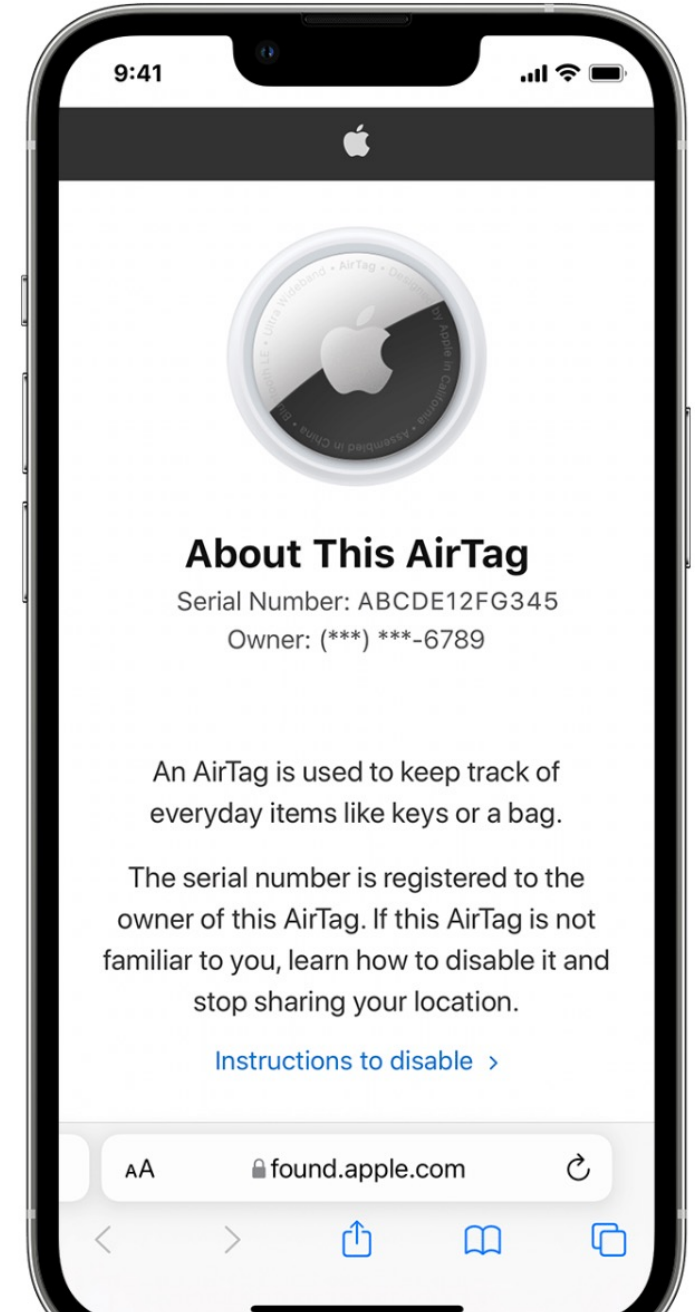
If you get an alert that an AirTag, AirPods, or another [Find My network accessory](#) is traveling with you, follow these steps to find it. First, check on the Find My app if you're able to play a sound on the unknown accessory:

1. Tap the alert.
2. Tap Continue and then tap Play Sound.
3. Listen for the sound. You can play it again if you need more time to find the item.



What To Do

To alert people nearby, any AirTag separated for a period of time from its owner will emit a sound when it's moved. I
