

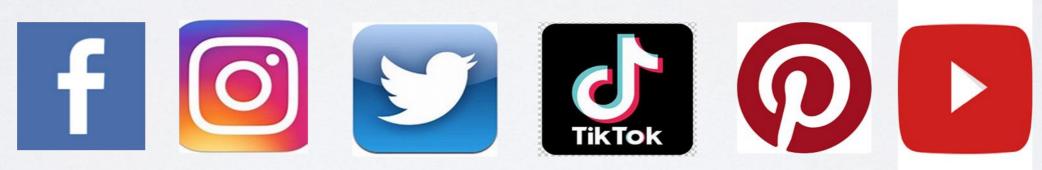

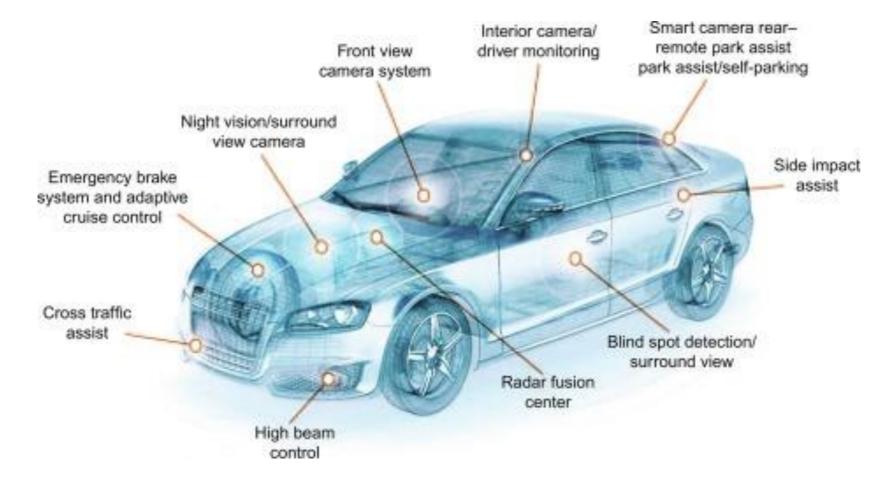

SOCIAL MEDIA TRENDS

- Older platforms have lower growth
- Most are very concerned about how to restrict inflammatory users/posts/tweets
- Many are being used to communicate ideas/plans for movements, marches, events
- Most are making a lot of money
- All are concerned about being regulated by the government

SOCIAL MEDIA ECONOMICS

- The primary way social media companies like Facebook and Twitter make money is through selling advertising.
- The concept of selling advertising while offering a free service is not new; television, newspapers, and media companies have been doing this long before social media companies existed.
- Social media platforms charge companies money so they can advertise on their site. The exact cost of that depends on many factors. For example, companies can pay more for their advert to be seen by more people or promoted for a longer period of time.

50% of People Use Social Media to Record Their Personal Milestones

Sprout Social asked survey respondents about whether they were likely to use social media during certain events:

- Personal milestones 50%
- Sporting events 45%
- Natural disasters 42%
- Holidays 42%
- Political events 39%
- Pop culture moments 38%

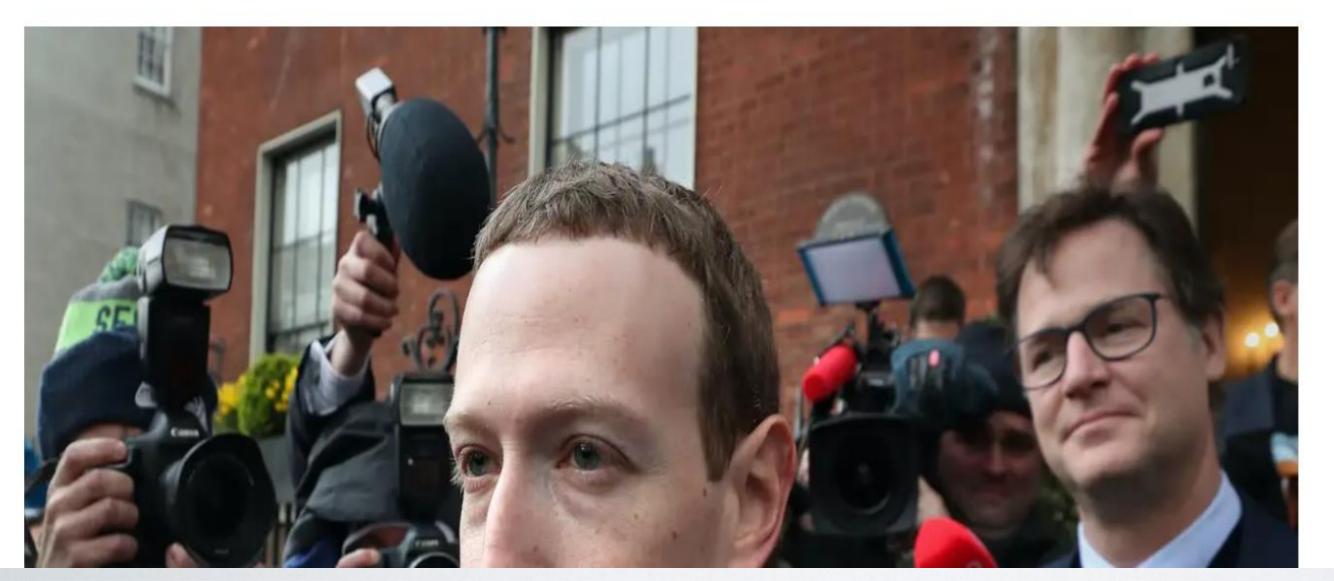

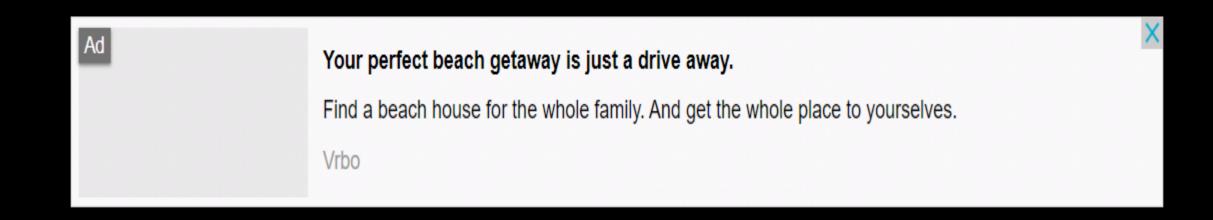

WHAT IS TWITTER?



- TWITTER is a microblogging and social networking service
- It was invented in 2006
- Users post and interact with messages known as "tweets"
- Tweets were originally restricted to 140 characters but that was doubled to 280 in 2017
- Early years saw significant growth but that has now leveled off

WHY IS TWITTER IMPORTANT?



- It has over 300 million monthly active users
- It reported \$3.46 billion in revenue in 2019
- It is a primary way by which some world leaders (Donald Trump) communicate
- 12% of Americans get their news from Twitter
- It has become an important source of information re COVID-19

WHO USES TWITTER?



- 22% of adults in the U.S. use Twitter
- Twitter is key for people whose jobs involve thinking and communicating
 - · Celebrities.....Journalists....Comedians....Sports Stars....Politicians
- Highest group (44%) of users are 18 to 24-year-olds
- A small number of users account for the vast majority of tweets
 - Most people use Twitter to "follow" someone or something

WHY IS TWITTER IMPORTANT?



For instance, when the US Airways plane crash-landed in the Hudson River in 2009, Janis Krums was **one of the first to spread the word via Twitter**, before many media outlets even caught on:

http://twitpic.com/135xa - There's a plane in the Hudson. I'm on the ferry going to pick up the people. Crazy.



BENEFITS OF USING TWITTER



- Tweets are publicity available (i.e. you don't have to join a "group")
- Tweets are short and easy to read
- Tweets are well suited for smart phones
- Tweets usually don't involve long discussions or "back and forth"
- Hashtags can be used to focus on specific topics (i.e. Coronavirus)
- You can follow trending news

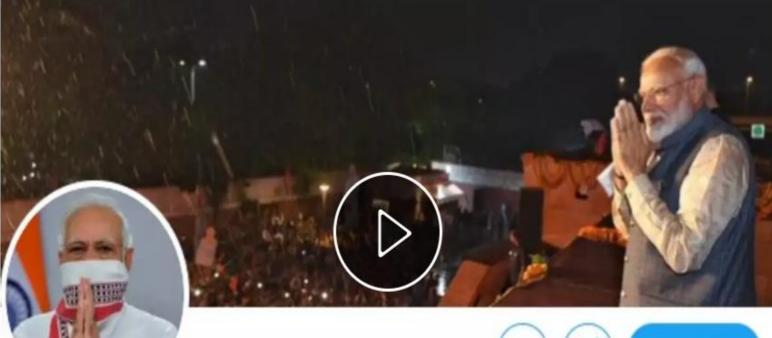

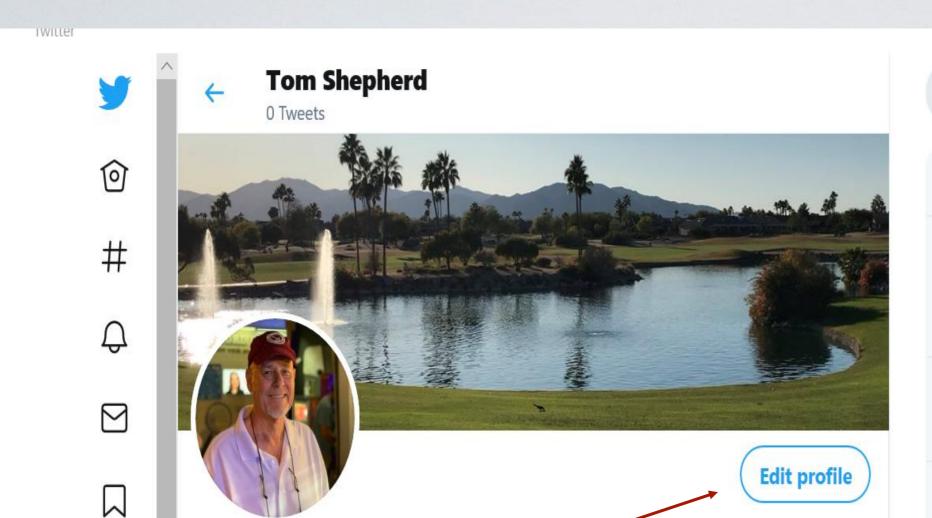

WHAT IS INSTAGRAM?



- Instagram is a social media platform where a person can share Images, post short videos, and communicate with friends
- · It is as an amalgam of the words "Instant Camera" and "Telegram""
- It was developed in San Francisco and launched in 2010
- · Early years saw significant growth but that has now leveled off
- It was purchased by Facebook in 2012 for \$1 Billion

WHY IS INSTAGRAM IMPORTANT?



- It has over 1 billion monthly active users
- · 71% of US businesses are on it
- Over 130 million users engage in shopping posts on a monthly basis

WHO USES INSTAGRAM?

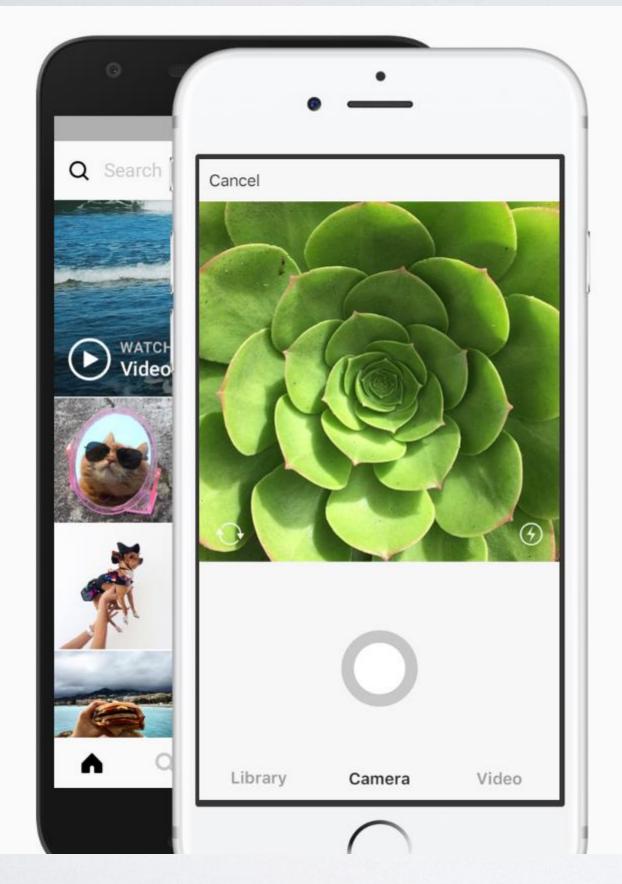


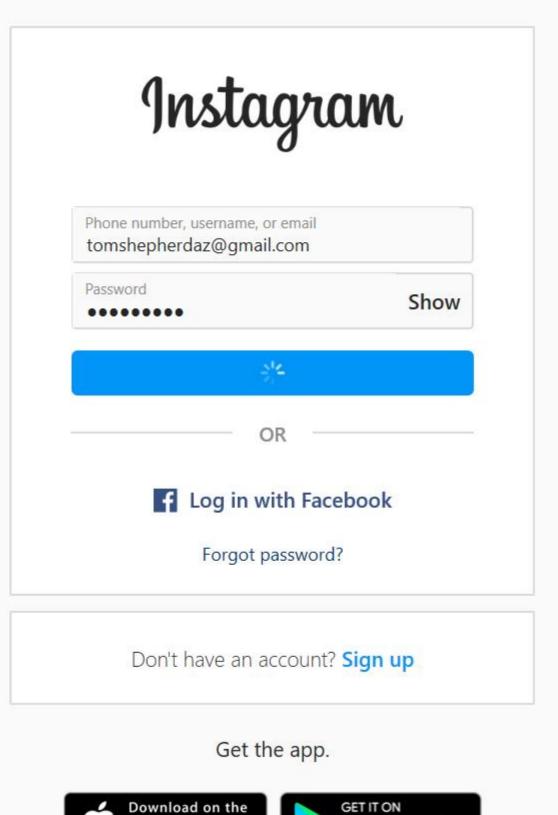
- 71% of users are under age 35
- Highest concentration of users is in U.S.
- Users browse an average of 53 minutes per day

BENEFITS OF USING INSTAGRAM



- Stay in touch with kids, grandkids, under the age of 35 who don't use Facebook
- It is kind of a simplified version of Facebook with an emphasis on mobile users and visual sharing

WHAT IS PINTEREST?



- Pinterest is a social network where people can find inspiration and ideas for their interests and hobbies
- Founded by former Google employees in 2010
- It has been called a "Catalog of Ideas"
- It is kind of a virtual pinboard or bulletin board
- · People post their favorite recipes, home and style inspirations

WHY IS PINTEREST IMPORTANT?



- It has over 416 million monthly average users
- It reported \$1 billion in revenue in 2019
- It is the 10th most relevant brand in the U.S.
- · It is the "go to" site for hobbyists and crafters

WHO USES PINTEREST?



- More than 2/3 of Pinterest user base is women
- More than 80% of US women with children use it
- More than ½ of users are outside of the U.S.

BENEFITS OF USING PINTEREST



- · It is a place to shop, primarily using visual images
 - 48% of users say shopping is a top activity
 - 85% of users put visuals first when shopping for apparel and furniture
- It can help answer questions like:
 - I don't know what to cook for dinner tonight
 - What color should I paint that bedroom

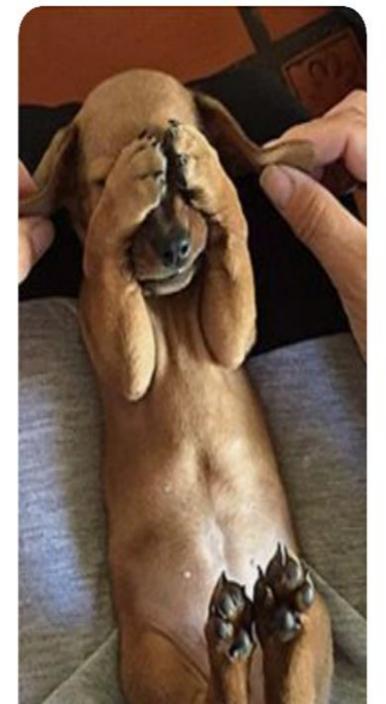


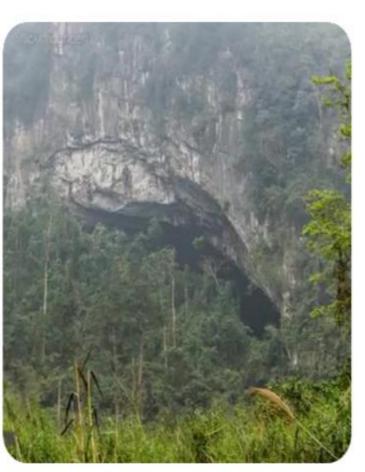






















WHAT IS TIKTOK?



- · It is one of the fastest growing social media platforms
- It allows users to create short videos with music, filters and many other features
- Early version introduced in 2016 in China by ByteDance
- Aug 2018 it became available worldwide
- ByteDance does not provide user statistics

WHY IS TIKTOK IMPORTANT?



- It is estimated to have over 800 million monthly active users
- It is the number one downloaded app in 2020
- Hugely popular in China, India and Brazil
- · Subject of pressure from U.S. Government

WHO USES TIKTOK?



- U.S. represents only 5% of TikTok users, but is seeing tremendous growth
- User base is skewed to youth
 - Ages 13-17 27%
 - Ages 18-24 42%

BENEFITS OF USING TIKTOK



- Great if you like to create short videos of yourself singing, dancing and lipsyncing
- · It is "micro entertainment"
- It provides "short bursts of distraction"

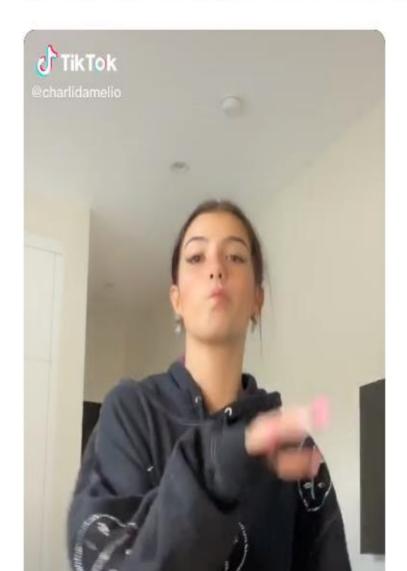

WHAT IS YOUTUBE?



- YouTube is an American <u>online video-</u> <u>sharing platform</u> headquartered in <u>San Bruno, California</u>.
- Three former <u>PayPal</u> employees—<u>Chad Hurley</u>, <u>Steve Chen</u>, and <u>Jawed Karim</u>—created the service in February 2005.
- Google bought the site in November 2006 for US\$1.65 billion
- YouTube now operates as one of Google's <u>subsidiaries</u>

WHY IS YOUTUBE IMPORTANT?



- As of Oct 2020, it is the second most popular website in the world, trailing only Google
- As of May 2019, more than 500 hours of video content are uploaded to YouTube every minute
- Based on reported quarterly advertising revenue, YouTube is estimated to have US\$15 billion in annual revenues
- The highest earner on the platform in 2019 was Ryan Kaji, raking in \$26 Million

WHO USES YOUTUBE?



- 73% of U.S. adults use YouTube
- 62% of businesses use YouTube
- 51% of YouTube users say they visit the site daily
- 37% of Millennials aged 18 34 binge watch it daily
- Many people make money by creating their own channels
- Number of channels earning six figures per year grows by 40% every year

BENEFITS OF USING YOUTUBE



- You can find videos for just about any household project
- You can find videos for many computer related subjects (how to replace a hard drive, how to add RAM, etc.)

WHAT IS FACEBOOK?

- Facebook is a social networking site that makes it easy for you to connect and share with family and friends online.
- · Ability to connect and share with the people you care about.
- Allows a user to connect to other media sources also; news, interest groups, organizations etc





WHY IS FACEBOOK IMPORTANT?



- Can find and connect with people in your age group that share similar interests (or maybe connect with a former boy or girl friend from grade school)
- Help you learn technology and keep your mind engaged
- Stay connected with friends and family
- Resource for playing games, keeping up with the news and relevant topics
- Also a big employer in the US & world
- Generates a lot of revenue through ads (\$18.32 Billion in 2020)

WHO USES FACEBOOK? BENEFITS OF FB

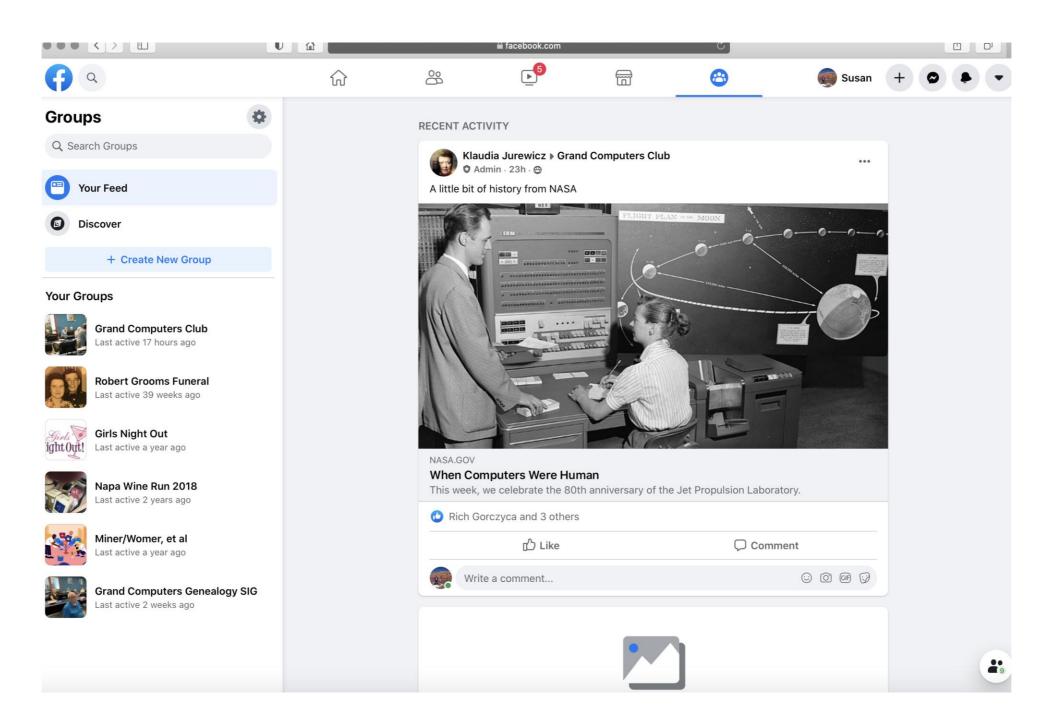


Everyone!

- Can access FB on smartphone, tablet or computer

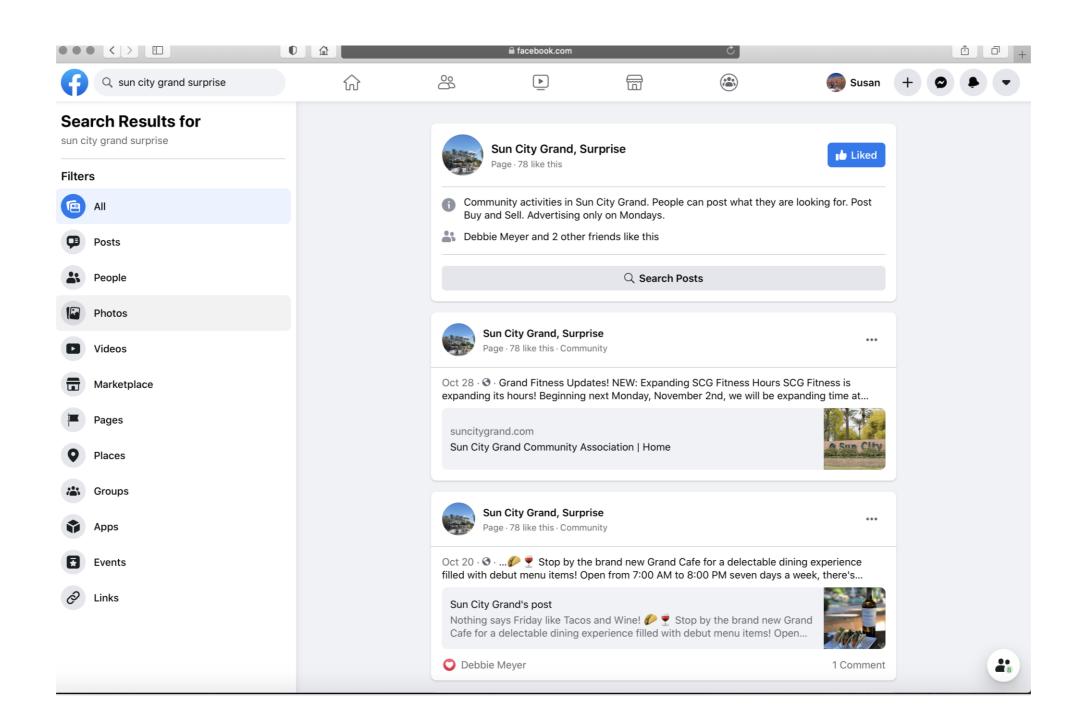

What is Reddit?

Reddit combines web content, social news, a forum, and a social network into one giant beast of a platform.

Registered members can contribute to the site with content such as images, text, videos, and links.

All content on the site can be voted up or down by other members.



This meritocratic system ensures that interesting content rises to the top and uninteresting content falls into an abyss.

As a result, Reddit is the birthplace of most internet memes and <u>viral sensations</u>.

- Keep it short

SOCIAL MEDIA DON'TS

- Don't pick a fight
- Don't post anything that could be used against you
- Don't post overly personal information
- Don't post rumors, hoaxes or urban legends
