What exactly is a "Web Browser"

A web browser (also referred to as an Internet browser or simply a browser) is application software for accessing the World Wide Web or a local website. When a user requests a web page from a particular website, the web browser retrieves the necessary content from a web server and then displays the page on the user's device.





1993 was a landmark year with the release of Mosaic, credited as "the world's first popular browser". Its innovative graphical user interface made the World Wide Web system easy to use and thus more accessible to the average person. This, in turn, sparked the Internet boom of the 1990s, when the Web grew at a very rapid rate. Marc Andreessen, the leader of the Mosaic team, soon started his own company, Netscape, which released the Mosaic-influenced Netscape, which released the Mosaic-influenced Netscape, Navigator in 1994. Navigator quickly became the most popular browser.





Microsoft debuted Internet Explorer in 1995, leading to a browser war with Netscape. Within a few years, Microsoft gained a dominant position in the browser market for two reasons: it bundled Internet Explorer with its popular Windows operating system and did so as freeware with no restrictions on usage. The market share of Internet Explorer peaked at over 95% in the early 2000s. [19]



In 1998, Netscape launched what would become the Mozilla Foundation to create a new browser using the open source software model. This work evolved into the Firefox browser, first released by Mozilla in 2004. Firefox market share peaked at 32% in 2010.



Apple released its Safari browser in 2003. Safari remains the dominant browser on Apple devices, though it did not become popular elsewhere



Google debuted its Chrome browser in 2008, which steadily took market share from Internet Explorer and became the most popular browser in 2012. Chrome has remained dominant ever since



Microsoft released its <u>Edge</u> browser in 2015 as part of the <u>Windows 10</u> release

What's the Difference Between a Web Browser and a "Search Engine"?

A web browser is not the same thing as a <u>search engine</u>, though the two are often confused. A search engine is a website that provides <u>links</u> to other websites. However, to connect to a website's server and display its web pages, a user must have a web browser installed.

Google

Is a company and it's original product was the Google Search Engine
But as mentioned earlier, it then developed it's own browser, Chrome

Microsoft

Originally had Internet Explorer, then replaced it recently with Edge

Edge is based on Chrome and looks very similar

Microsoft also has their own Search Engine, called Bing


These various browsers were developed back "in the day" when most users accessed the Web from either a PC or a Mac



That meant that users had a fairly large screen, a full keyboard, and a mouse




This became more complicated with the rise of handheld devices, i.e. smart phones



Now these browsers had to adapt to the much smaller screen sizes of smart phones, and the usage of a touch screen



Today the browsers have mostly the same capabilities on a PC/Mac or Smart Phone But Things look different on the phone



Some capabilities of the browser are not shown by default on the phone because there is just not enough room; you may have to scroll up or down, or in some cases, swipe left or right, to find more options

Each company has a default browser for their devices

Apple has Safari
Windows PCs have Edge
Android devices have Chrome

What if I don't want to use the default on my device?

You can install Chrome, and most people do, on Windows PCs
You can also install Chrome on an Apple product

What if I don't want to use the default on my device?

Many Windows/PC users still use Firefox It is something they are familiar with and still is very good

Note for Windows 11

With Windows 11, Microsoft is really pushing users to adopt Edge
It is integrated into many aspects of 11 and you have to "opt out" not to use it

What is a Bookmark? Here's a formal definition

Using a World Wide Web <u>browser</u>, a bookmark is a saved link to a Web <u>page</u> that has been added to a list of saved links. When you are looking at a particular Web site or <u>home page</u> and want to be able to quickly get back to it later, you can create a bookmark for it. You can think of your browser as a book full of (millions of) Web pages and a few well-placed bookmarks that you have chosen. The list that contains your bookmarks is the "bookmark list" (and sometimes it's called a "hotlist.")



Bookmarks vs Favorites Are they the same?

Bookmarks and Favorites are very similar
Some browsers use them interchangeably
Their function is to allow you to save a "placeholder" for accessing a web site

you frequently use


Either one speeds up the process because you don't have to search, you just

click on the "placeholder"


Where do I put my bookmarks

For Google Chrome, bookmarks show up on the Bookmarks "Bar"


Here is Google Chrome on a Windows 11 Laptop This is plain vanilla with no bookmarks




Click on the three dots




And this little window pops up on the left – see where is says Bookmarks, well click on that




And then you get options to Bookmark this tab and more importantly, show Bookmarks bar




I clicked "Show bookmarks bar" but nothing happens That's because I don't have any bookmarks yet – lets create one




Let's say I want to access Amazon a lot – first I do a search




Here is what the search shows – I will click the first entry




Up pops up the Amazon page – now to create a bookmark for this so I don't have to go through all this again, click the three dots again




The little window pops up again on the right, I select Bookmarks and then Bookmark this tab




Now the little window shows me it is going to create a book and put it in the Bookmarks bar

And here is an example with lots of bookmarks on the bookmark bar




What about Apple users and Safari?



THE BASICS OF BOOKMARKS AND FAVORITES

The bookmarks on Safari function like any other browser — you save links in it. For proper organization, you can create different folders under bookmarks to categorize your links. For instance, you can have your tech links in one folder, sports links in another, and so on.




Favorites is a pre-made category under bookmarks. You can call it a special type of bookmarks folder bestowed with certain privileges.

SPECIALTY OF FAVORITES


The thing that makes links under the favorites category special is that they are available on the home screen of Safari. That is, links under favourites show up as shortcuts when you open a new tab in Safari browser. Thanks to that, you can access certain sites quickly with just a tap or two.




To find Book marks, first click here




There is another handy technique called Tabs

This can be helpful when you are working with more than one website at a time






What are Pop-Ups?


Why would you block pop-ups?


In Google Chrome, you can choose whether to allow or block Pop-Ups

Open Chrome Browser and click on the three dots











What if the words are too small for me to read?


Click on the three dots




Click on zoom




Increasing the zoom, in this case to 150%, makes things Larger



To print, select the three dots and chose print



If you want to review your recently used web pages, click on History



Can I have more than one browser on my device?

Yes, and there may be times when that is helpful

Sometimes, for whatever reason, a particular website may not work 100% correctly with a certain browser

You can often get around this by simply using a different browser for that same website

For example, the default browser on an Apple devices is Safari

You can easily download Google
Chrome from the Apple store, install it
on your device, and use it instead of
Safari









Similarly, if you are on Windows and having problems with a website on Google Chrome

There may be times when a help desk person tells you to "Clear your cache"


What does that mean?



When you use a browser, like Chrome, it saves some information from websites in its cache and cookies.

Clearing them fixes certain problems, like loading or formatting issues on sites

All the browsers have a function to clear cache

In Chrome

- 1. On your computer, open Chrome.
- 2. At the top right, click More : .
- 3. Click More tools > Clear browsing data.
- 4. At the top, choose a time range. To delete everything, select All time.
- 5. Next to "Cookies and other site data" and "Cached images and files," check the boxes.
- 6. Click Clear data.

At the top right, tap More

Tap History and then Clear browsing data.

Tap Clear data.



Here is one definition of ChatGPT

ChatGPT (Generative Pre-trained Transformer) is a chatbot launched by OpenAl in November 2022.

It is built on top of OpenAI's GPT-3 family of large language models, and is fine-tuned (an approach to transfer learning) with both supervised and reinforcement learning techniques.

ChatGPT: What it is and how it works

ChatGPT is a free chatbot that's available online as a research preview, which OpenAl says will allow the system to learn from real-world use. You can ask ChatGPT straightforward queries like "Show me healthy dinner ideas" or "What's the best way to answer the 'tell me about yourself' question in a job interview?" But ChatGPT can also do things like write poems, songs and essays. You can ask it to compose a holiday greeting card, organize your to-do list and even draft a resignation letter.

The Al is trained on large volumes of data from the internet written by humans, including conversations. But ChatGPT isn't connected to the internet, so it sometimes produces incorrect answers and has limited knowledge.

This has already caused chaos in the world of Education

If a student is given an assignment such as "Write a three-page document that explains how the Wright Brothers invented the airplane"

That student could type those words into an online chat with ChatGpt and it would spit out the document

Instructors did not initially realize those student papers were being written for them by ChatGpt

Now most colleges and high schools have programs in place to detect and block ChatGpt answers

Fewer programmers may be needed

ChatGpt can generate computer code/programs

One good programmer can now legitimately do what not so long ago was the work of many, and people who have never programmed will soon be able to create workable code as well.

Here is another definition

ChatGPT is a large language model (LLM). Large Language Models (LLMs) are trained with massive amounts of data to accurately predict what word comes next in a sentence.

It was discovered that increasing the amount of data increased the ability of the language models to do more.

Some more information

According to **Stanford University**:

"GPT-3 has 175 billion parameters and was trained on 570 gigabytes of text. For comparison, its predecessor, GPT-2, was over 100 times smaller at 1.5 billion parameters.

This increase in scale drastically changes the behavior of the model — GPT-3 is able to perform tasks it was not explicitly trained on, like translating sentences from English to French, with few to no training examples.


