1. What's New in Family Tree Maker **2005**

- * **New Family View** page - You can now view 3 generations at once, the primary couple, more children & more info about these children and the couple's parents.
 - * **Pedigree View** - displays 3 to 7 generations at once (with side panel info & controls) & additional info on any individual that you select in the tree.
 - * **Edit Individual dialog box** - (improved version of the former "More About" page) Allows you to record & view a wide variety of additional information about each person in your family tree.
 - * **Web Search** - FTM now automatically combs online databases for genealogical data about a selected individual. You can compare the information side by side.
 - * **Web Merge** - helps you quickly & easily add any information found through the Web Search directly to your family file. When you use Web Merge it incorporates the information, including source information, into your family file without changing or overwriting any of your existing data.
 - * **Bookmark & History** - With the new Bookmark feature, you can mark individuals that you want to be able to refer to quickly, while the History list gives you easy access to the last 30 individuals edited.
 - * **Default Date Format** - All dates default to the *dd mmm yyyy* format (example: 12 Oct 2004), the genealogical standard in recording dates.

2. What's New in Family Tree Maker **2006**

- **Charting Companion** - customize, print & publish generations of your family tree - 16 million colors
- **Source Usage Report** - can easily connect a single citation to multiple facts with the Copy and Paste feature. You can quickly identify & replace duplicate master sources without losing any information.
- **Notes** - can add up to 1 MB of text, which is 4 times the amount of 05

- **Linked to Ancestry.com** - ALL records stored in FTM 06 can now be linked directly to the related source records on Ancestry.com
- **Merge Ancestry.com records** - with the individuals in your records and you can edit the citation information before merging.
- **Family Facts**- Facts about your surname and see where your ancestors are likely to have originated (what country)? Find out the meaning of their names.
- **Research Tips** - Tips on which records to research in order to locate your ancestors.
