

Examples of the Top 10+

- Fake Lottery you might get a call saying you have won a million dollars
 & need to pay administrative fees/taxes to receive the money
- **Grandparent scam** a call or email posing as a law enforcement person claiming to represent a family member in distress (in jail, accident, being held hostage etc). They might also pose as the "grandchild" & ask you to guess who is calling. They want you to wire money to pay for medical or legal bills



More Examples

- Fake Virus or Ransomware -Pop up browser windows simulating virusscanning software may fool victims into downloading fake anti-virus programs at substantial cost OR actual virus where scammers have direct access to your computer. 2. Popup that claims your computer has been or will be locked if you don't pay immediately & all files will be deleted.
- Tech Support Scam scammers claim to be from a legitimate company
 & will fix problem that doesn't exist.



More Examples

• **Email/Phishing** - You receive an email or text message that appears to be from a legitimate company asking you to "update" OR "verify" your personal information.

From: NETFLIX

MSG: We encountered issues processing the latest payment for your Netflix Subscription

And the account is temporarily restricted,

Please Update your billing information at
