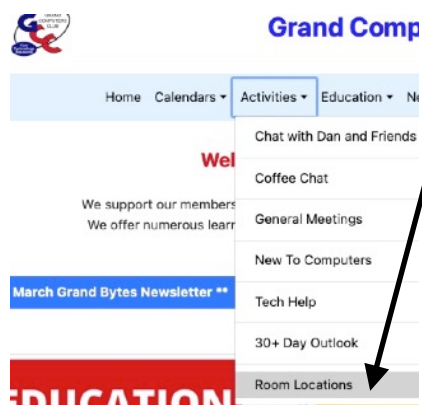

Where is my meeting room location?

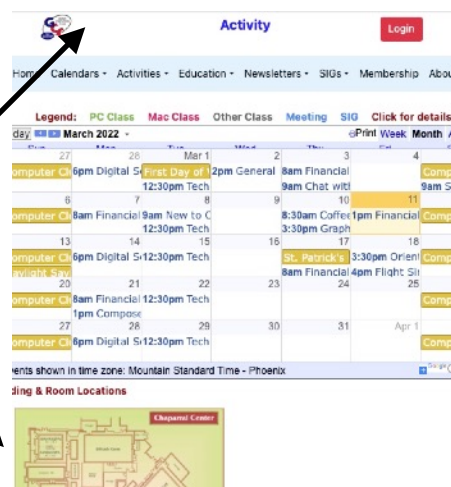
It's posted in **two locations** on the website:
