EDUCATION – ONLINE CLASSES VIA ZOOM

Remember – when you register for a class and immediately on payment of the class:

- A. You receive the **unique link** emailed to you from “**GCC Education**”. Each student receives their own unique link.
- B. No two links are the same for the class.
- C. When the class has two or more sessions, you will receive a link for each session from **GCC Education**.
- D. SAVE EACH LINK –**
- E. CHECK THE DATES ON THE LINK BEFORE JOINING THE CLASS.**

As our emails come in and the emails move down in priority, we have a tendency to lose them or cannot find the email we are looking for.

Suggestion:

- 1. Create a new label in your email account**
- 2. Name it: Zoom or Zoom classes and meetings**

Here's how to review the list of classes being offered and how to register for a class or classes of your choice.

1. Click the Education Tab for the menu.
2. Click Class Registration to see the list of classes being offered.
3. Click the Register button to register for the class.
4. On the menu click Overview if you need assistance registering, paying with PayPal or your credit card and Zoom requirements to attend classes.
