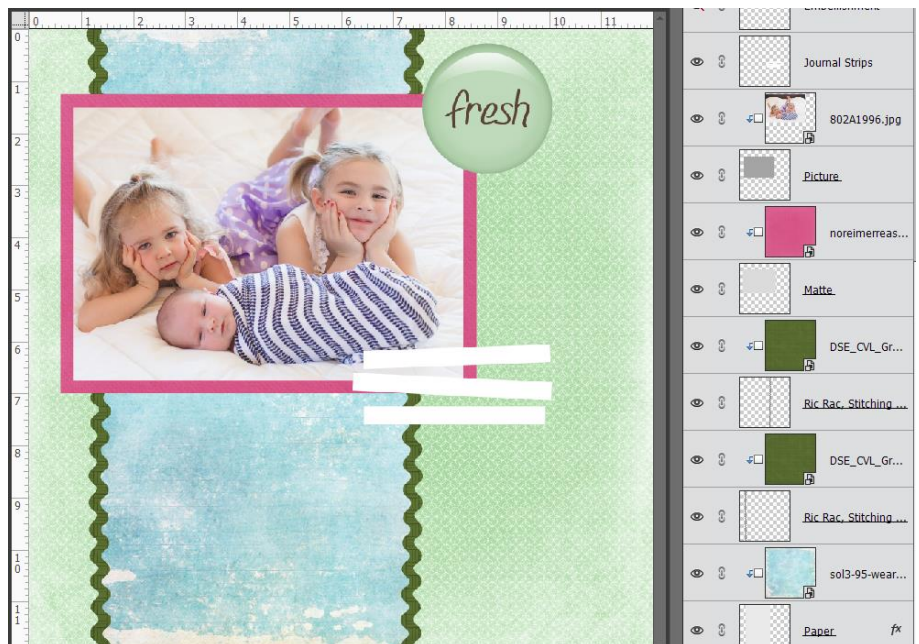


PREPARING TO BUILD

1. Open you Layered Template PSD
2. Look at the Layers Panel. Count the number of Papers (including Background).
3. Note: The Matte and the Ric Rac strips are possible areas for papers.
4. There are 4 papers, 1 picture and Embellishments.
5. Go to your stash and open these elements (makes it easier to do this if you have kits so elements go together).

FILLING IN YOUR TEMPLATE

1. Look at your Layers Panel, notice the different shades of gray to match to grays in template.
2. Be on Background layer (note it is nor really a background, it is just the bottom layer).
3. Drag the paper you want to be the bottom from the Photo Bin to the template. If it does not go directly above the background move it there. You will do this same thing as you go along.
4. Be on the next Paper layer.
5. Drag another paper to your template. Position it on the Layer Panel above the paper.
6. On your Menu Bar > Layer >Create Clipping Mask
7. Work your way up the papers with these steps. (Including the strips)
8. The image above is what my page looked like after adding pictures. You can also see a portion of the Layers Panel.
9. The very top layer is one that will delete or turn off so you don't have the word picture on top of your picture.
10. You can save the creation as a TIFF prior to adding pictures. (Possibly for 2-page spread)



ADDING PICTURES & TEXT

1. Add the picture to your creation using the same Create Clipping Mask
2. Add any title of journaling to complete the page.
