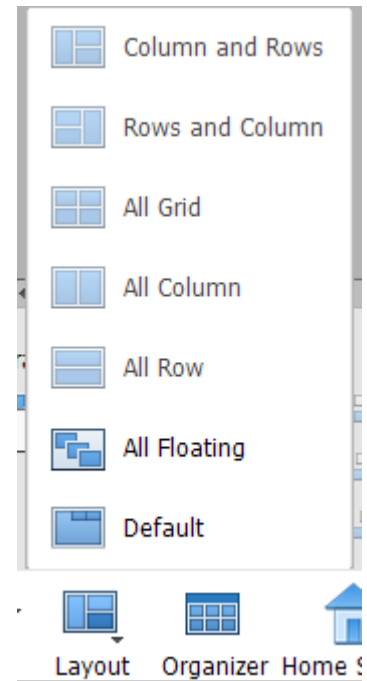


DOCK & FLOAT, LAYOUTS IN ELEMENTS PHOTO EDITOR

In the same area where you have the Photo Bin and Tool Options there is a LAYOUT icon. When you click that you will get the different options for the way you can see multiple pictures in the workspace.

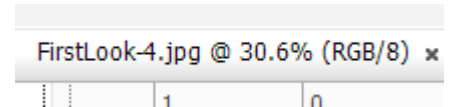
Note: You must have set the option in your Preferences to Allow Floating Documents.

The Default is Docked. The other one that is commonly used is Floating.



If you think of your images as boats, when they are docked they are tied up along the top of the work area and when they are floating they can move around in the workspace.

Each image has a title at the top. To move a picture so you can dock or float it you must put your cursor on this title, hold down your left mouse key and move it.



TO UNDOCK - FLOAT

Hold down cursor on title bar and drag the image down to the workspace, release.

TO DOCK

Hold down cursor on title bar and drag up to the top of the workspace, when it is in the right place it will gray out, release.
